BORDER SECURITY PROTOCOL

- No violence
- No Protesting or Activism (This is not a protest)
- Do not swear or use vulgar words to anyone, maintain professionalism.
- Wear Safety vests
- No masks or other "gang" looking clothing, No camouflage clothing
- Dress warm (long hours out in the cold)
- YOU WILL NOT TALK TO MEDIA (that's only for Chief and Council, or a designated person)
- Stay in contact with each other at all times
- You will not collect fees or any other gifts from anyone to gain entry.
- There are certain companies that have a letter of entry from the Lands Dept.
- When people ask why this is happening;
 - 1. Local Companies and Local people are being bypassed or pushed out of work and outsider companies and workers are being brought in.
 - 2. Failed Meaningful consultation
 - 3. Disregarded Impact Benefit Agreements
 - 4. Neglected referendum on transfer and admin of highways
 - 5. CNRL and Husky want to use our Drinking Water for Oil extraction

- Any questions that cannot be answered immediately by the Lead hand will be forwarded to the Land Manager or Lands Officer.
- Do not give out the Land Manager's or Land Officer cell phone number everyone that needs it already has it.
- NO Drugs or Alcohol on site, please ask the public to leave if they appear to be under influence.
- There will be no tolerance for Border Security to be under the slightest influence of Drugs or Alcohol, any member of security caught doing so will be sent home immediately and replaced.
