Re: Requirement to Establish a Joint Work Site Health and Safety Committee or Designate a Health and Safety Representative

Pursuant to section 16(1)(b) of the *Occupational Health and Safety Act*, c O-2.1 SA 2017, I hereby designate the following work sites as requiring the employer to establish a joint work site health and safety committee:

- all work sites in Alberta where the employer employs 20 or more workers and work is expected to last 90 days or more.

Pursuant to section 17(1)(b) of the *Occupational Health and Safety Act*, c O-2.1 SA 2017, I hereby designate the following work sites as requiring the employer to designate a health and safety representative:

- all work sites in Alberta where the employer employs 5 to 19 workers and work is expected to last 90 days .

These designations come into effect on June 1, 2018 and remain in effect until rescinded by a Director.
