**ORDER GRANTING RELEASE PENDING APPEAL AND
INTERRUPTING SENTENCE**

Conrad M. Black, USM# 18330-424, was convicted following trial in the Northern District of Illinois, on three counts of mail fraud (18 U.S.C. §§ 1341, 1346) and one count of obstructing justice (18 U.S.C. § 1512), and sentenced on December 10, 2007 to, *inter alia*, a 78-month term of imprisonment, which he has been serving since March 3, 2008 at FCI Coleman (Low), a facility of the United States Bureau of Prisons in Florida.

On July 19, 2010, following a remand from the United States Supreme Court, the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit granted Mr. Black's application for bail pending further disposition of his appeal.

The Court of Appeals further ordered that the matter is remanded to the District Court "for the limited purpose of permitting the district court to determine the conditions of release."


Today, July 21, 2010, this Court has entered an Order Setting Conditions of Release.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED:

The sentence of Conrad M. Black (USM# 18330-424) is hereby interrupted, and he shall be released forthwith from the Bureau of Prisons and the Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

Conrad M. Black shall abide by the conditions set forth in this Court's Order Setting Conditions of Release.
