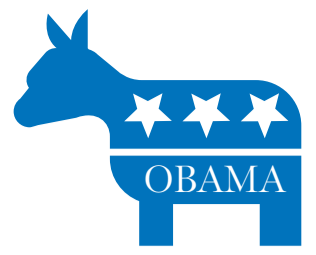

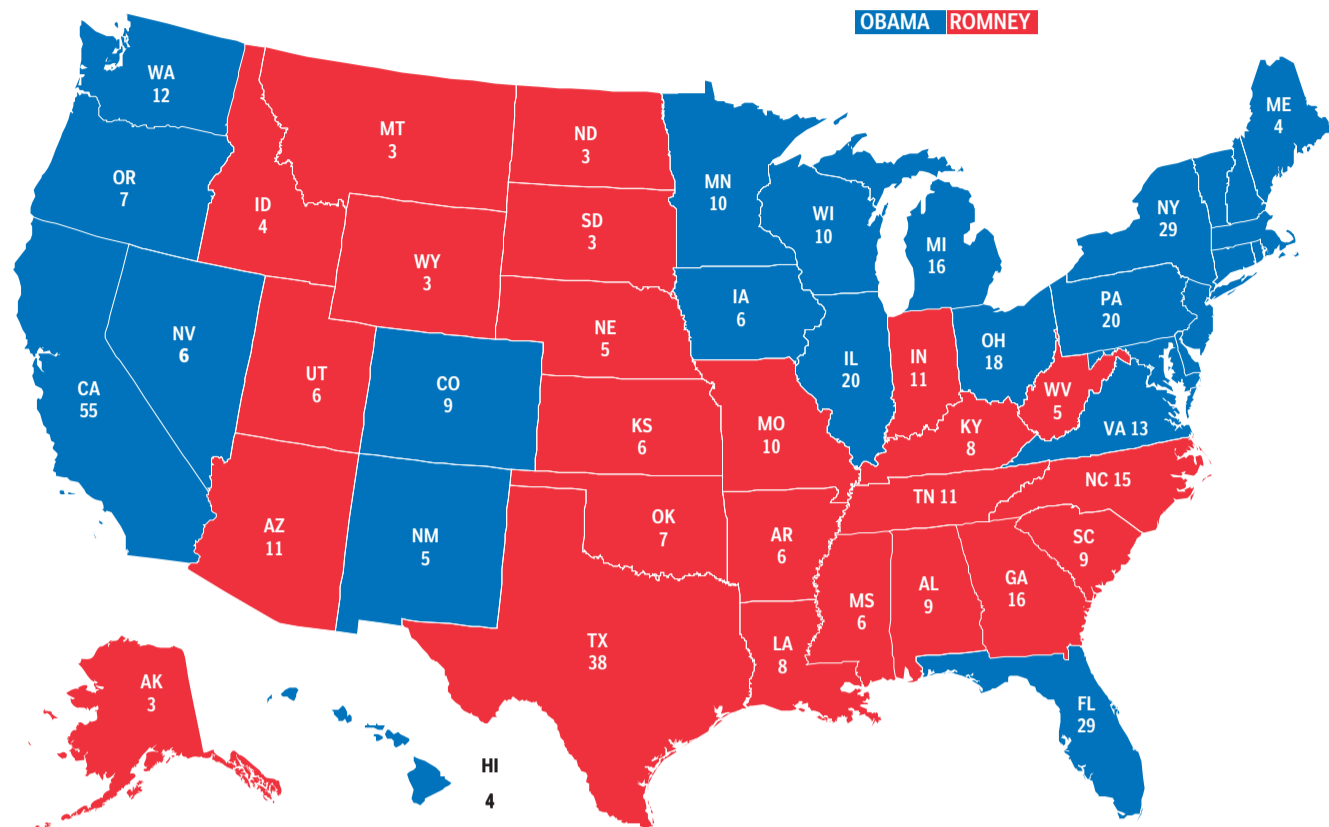

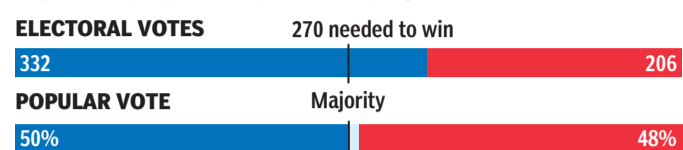

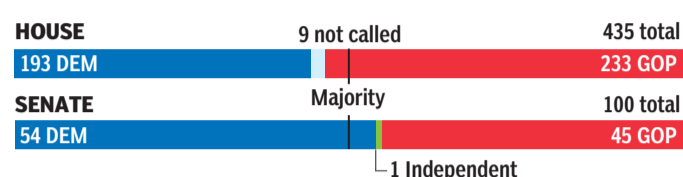
2012 STATE WINNERS 49 States reporting nationwide in presidential race



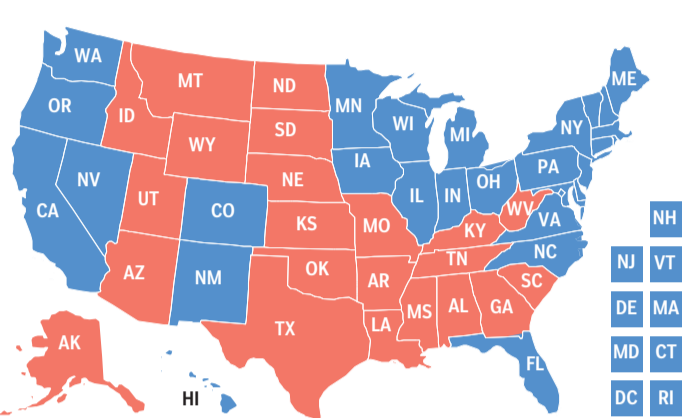
2012 PRESIDENTIAL RACE



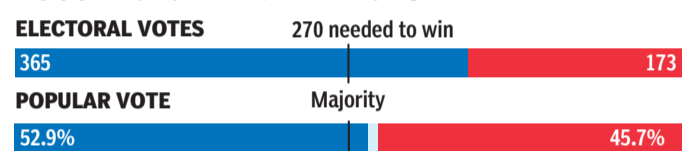
CONGRESSIONAL BALANCE OF POWER



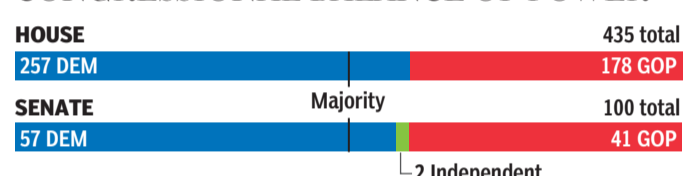

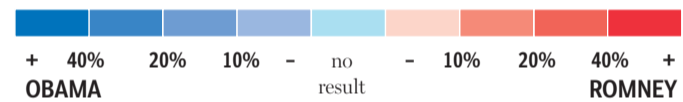

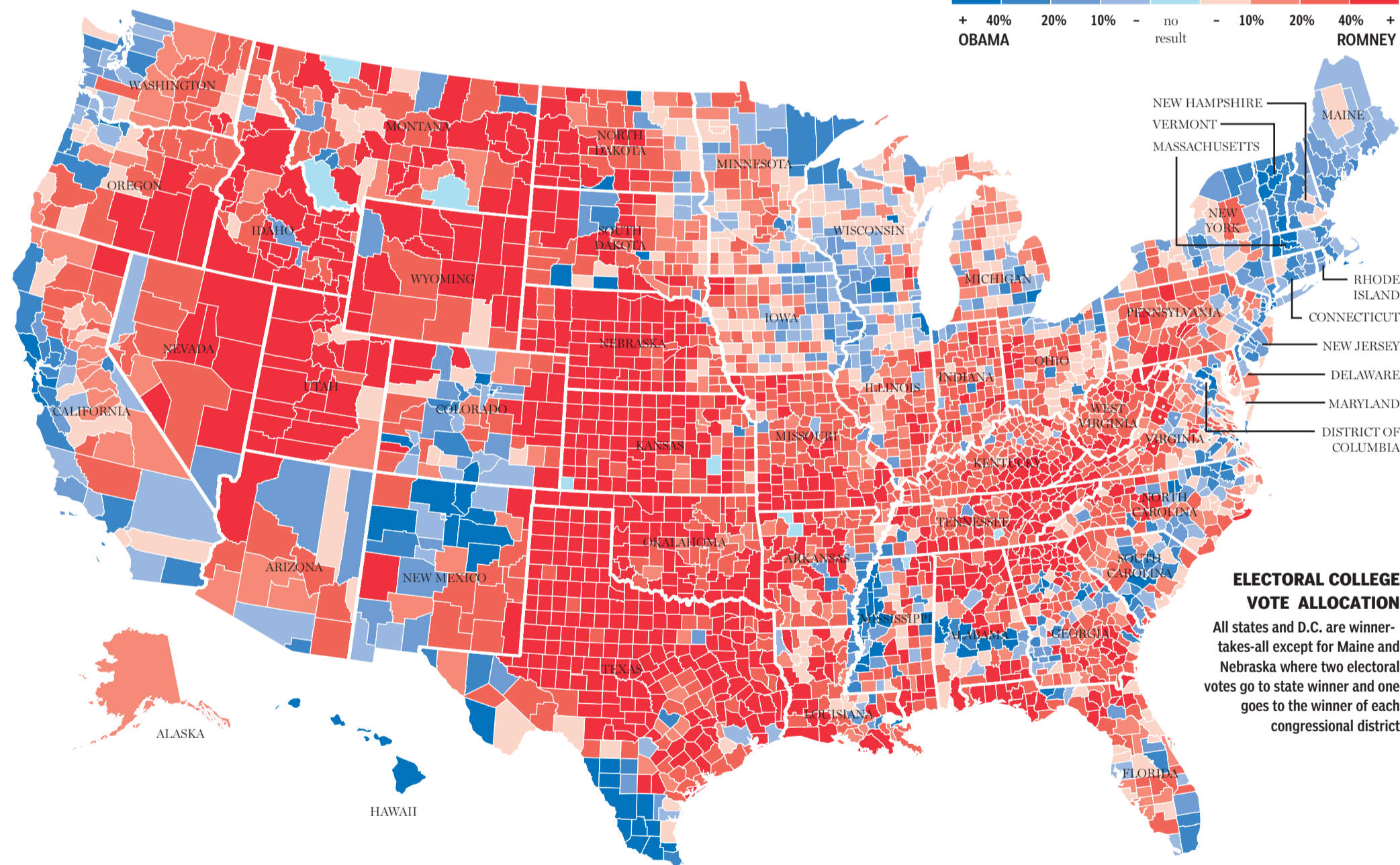
CONGRESSIONAL BALANCE OF POWER



MARGIN OF LEAD



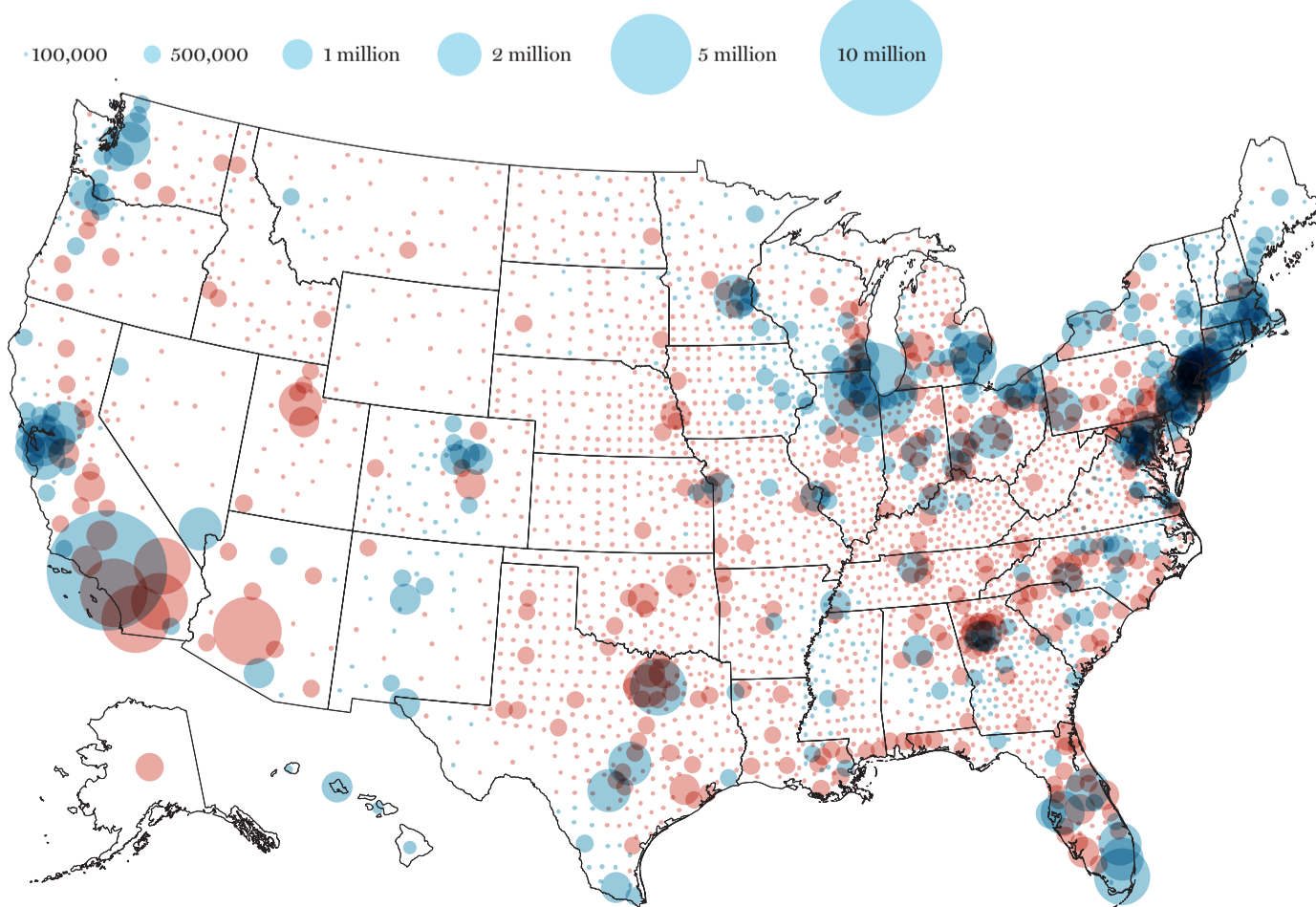
THE 2012 GEOGRAPHY OF THE POPULAR VOTE



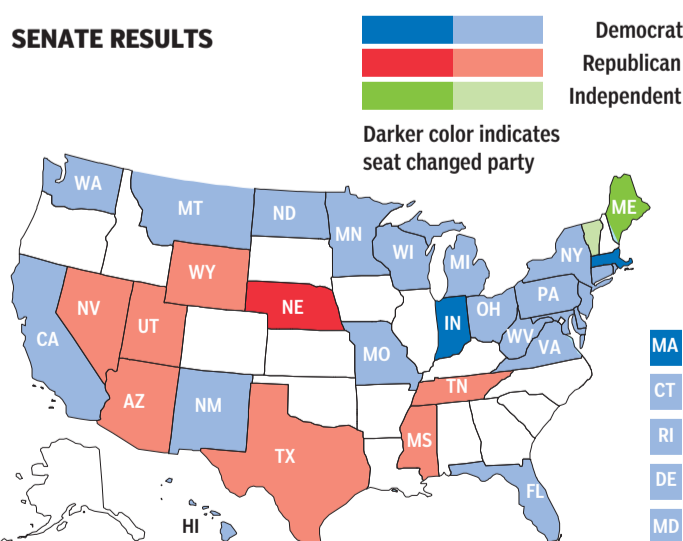
ELECTORAL COLLEGE VOTE ALLOCATION
