

## \* STAY HOME, AMERICA! == CANADA CALLS THE ELECTION

If Canadians were electing the next U.S. president Tuesday, these polling results would have Mitt Romney holding his head in his hands. In almost every measure of polling demographic, including having the winner live next door, Barack Obama is a clear favourite. 
Q. IF YOU COULD VOTE IN THE U.S. PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION, WHO WOULD YOU VOTE FOR?






