Progressive Conservatives Extend Advantage Over NDP in Manitoba

New Democrats and PC Party are virtually even in Winnipeg.

[WINNIPEG – Jun. 10, 2010] – The opposition Progressive Conservative Party keeps the upper hand in Manitoba, a new Angus Reid Public Opinion poll has found.

In the online survey of a representative provincial sample of 800 Manitoban adults, 48 per cent of decided voters (+4 since February) would support the Progressive Conservative candidate in their constituency if a provincial election were held tomorrow. The governing New Democratic Party (NDP) is second with 36 per cent (-1), followed by the Liberal Party with 13 per cent (=), and the Green Party with three per cent (=).

Demographics

The Progressive Conservatives hold an 18-point advantage over the NDP among males (52% to 34%) and a six-point lead among women (44% to 38%). The Liberals continue to do better among women (15%) than men (9%). The NDP is virtually tied with the Tories in Winnipeg (42% to

From May 26 to June 1, 2010, Angus Reid Public Opinion conducted an online survey among 800 randomly selected Manitoban adults who are Angus Reid Forum panelists. The margin of error—which measures sampling variability—is +/-3.5%. The results have been statistically weighted according to the most current education, age, gender and region Census data to ensure samples representative of the entire adult population of Manitoba. Discrepancies in or between totals are due to rounding.

41%), but the opposition party has a substantial lead in rural Manitoba (58% to 28%).

These findings are part of The Angus Reid Report, the most comprehensive public opinion report ever developed in Canada.
