
the lead for MAVED will be Rod Macdonald; from MED Jacquie Kendall. still waiting to hear from MCFD.

Emery/Chris/Gerry,

The purpose of this email is to request your support in having Treasury Board Staff analysts join the work on potential labour market reform.

As you are aware through discussions with the Lee, Vince and Rick, we are looking at what labour reforms may be required to allow the restructuring that needs to take place in the public sector. It is expected that these changes will result in lower cost administrative and operating structures.

It is recognized that you have been asked to identify any needed changes, the impact of those changes and associated financial benefits. Treasury Board Staff are being asked to review the numbers to ensure they are tracked in a consistent manner.

Lee has asked that TBS contact the ministries and begin working with them. The timeline is short and we are to review a draft report next Friday.

I have asked Jim and Heather to contact you each directly to discuss who you wish to assign to work with analysts on this work. (TBS has already made contact with Health Services in this regard.) Please expect a call shortly.
