BY-LAW NUMBER 6153

A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT DEPOSITING OF SNOW AND ICE UPON THE HIGHWAYS OF THE CITY OF WINDSOR

Passed the 29th day of January, 1979.

WHEREAS paragraph 1 of Section 460 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284 provides that councils of all municipalities may pass by-laws for prohibiting or regulating the obstructing, encumbering, injuring or fouling of highways or bridges;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to prohibit persons from obstructing or encumbering highways by depositing of snow or ice thereon;

THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Windsor enacts as follows:

- 1. In this by-law,
 - (a) "highway" means a common and public highway, and includes a sidewalk, a street, an alley, and a bridge forming part of ahighway or on, over or across which a highway passes;
 - (b) "lands" includes any buildings thereon;
 - (c) "occupant" includes,
 - (i) the owner, or duly authorized representative or agent, where lands are occupied by the owner,
 - (ii) the tenant or person in possession where lands are not occupied by the owner.
- 2. No person or occupant of land shall obstruct or encumber any highway in the City of Windsor by depositing or permitting to be deposited snow and ice from such lands upon such highway.
- 3. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law (Chapter) is guilty of an offence and shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a penalty of not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000), exclusive of costs and every such fine is recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act. - 4. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
