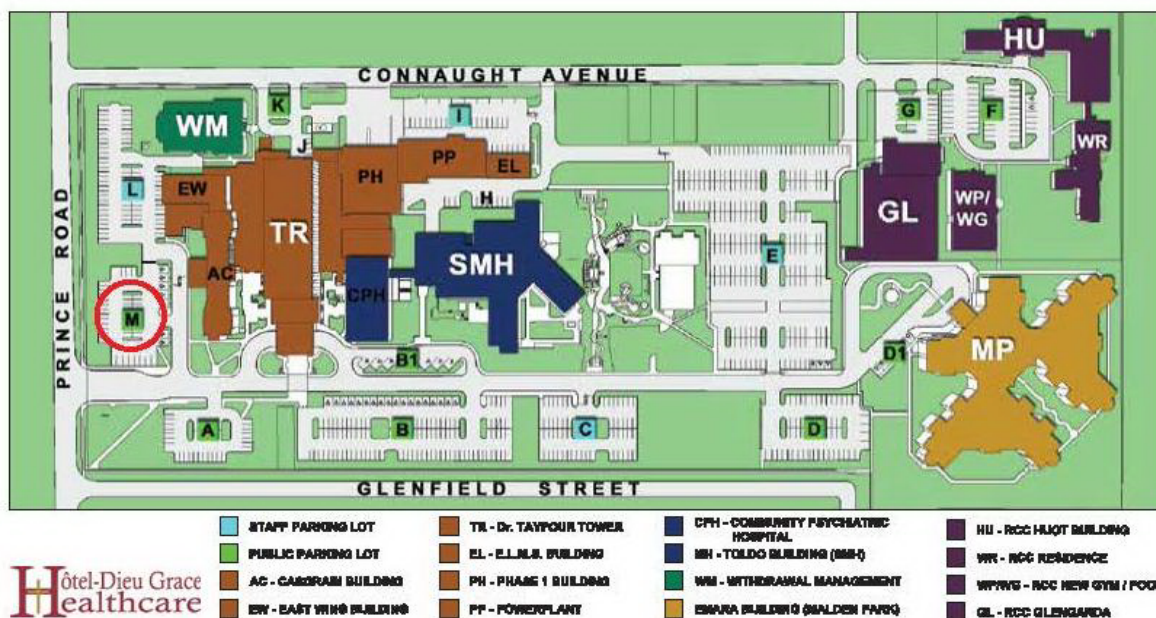

HDGHealthcare Opens New Visitors Lot

Windsor, ON – Effective April 20th, 2015, Hôtel-Dieu Grace Healthcare will be opening a new visitor's & outpatient parking lot at 1453 Prince Road. Currently Lot M and L are staff parking lots however in an effort to accommodate visitors, outpatients and our employees, Lot M will become a visitors lot and Lot L will remain a staff parking lot effective April 20th, 2015.



All visitors in lots A, B, D and M must display a “pay and display ticket” or a monthly parking pass/tokens (available from the Cashiers office). This applies to all designated Accessible Parking Permit spots as well. As with other hospitals, all parking costs are directly invested in the operational costs related to the hospital.

The following parking rates are in effect for Hôtel-Dieu Grace Healthcare:

Monthly Parking Passes

- \$35.00 for the calendar month
- 10 tokens for \$25.00

Machine rates:

- \$3.00 for the first hour
- \$1.00 for every additional ½ hour
- \$7.00 full day - until midnight that day.

All revenue generated from the parking rates support the hospital with the maintenance of the surface parking lots as well as all of the landscaping requirements and winter snow removal.

Please note that parking is available at no charge to Veterans whose License Plate includes a Poppy however the vehicle must be parked in a regular parking spot unless it otherwise also has an Accessible Parking Permit.

In an effort to minimize pedestrian travel for visitors/patients that utilize designated Accessible Parking Permit parking:

- Monthly parking permits can be purchased and put on the dash of their car
- Pulling up next to the machine and making payment with coins or tokens and then proceeding to their parking spot
