I GIVE, DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all my property of every nature and kind to THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WINDSOR in trust for the following purposes and I hereinafter refer to it as my trustee.

To use it's discretion in the realization of my estate with power to my trustee to sell, call in convert into money at such time or times and in such manner and upon such terms as my said trustee may at it's discretion deem advised.

TO TRANSFER all the residue of my estate to the Corporation of the City of Windsor to build a building to be known as the "CHIMCZUK MUSEUM" for use as a cultural museum and archives and library.




