It's full on flavour and great value at Franco's, newly built and now open after a kitchen fire gutted the restaurant in December 2018.

"We are pleased to welcome loyal and new guests to our new place," says John Donato. He and his wife, Josie, have owned Franco's since

retire — or at least slow down starting New Year's Day 2019. The fire delayed their plans for a year as our family restaurant needed their expertise," says Frank Donato. "Finally, this month, they are able to give retirement another shot."

> our flavour or quality." 'We've always sourced and bought local ingredients, long before it became a trend," Donato reflects. "It's more personal. I meet with the growers and producers, who take as much pride in the ingredients they raise as we do in the food we serve.
